Also, receiving special recognition that night were Bill Albert and George Kresch on their 50 continuous years of membership in the Knights of Columbus.

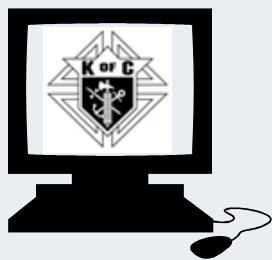
